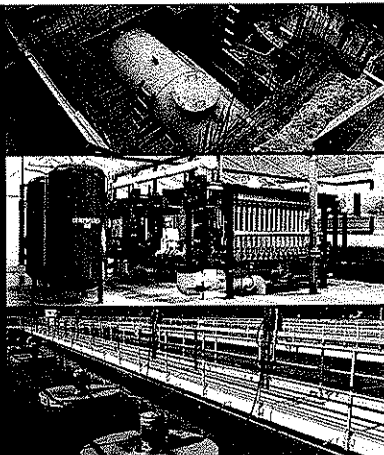
that maximizes their ESOP values for their employees' benefit and demonstrates outstanding professional leadership within the community.
