Pottstown engineering firm awarded bridge projects

Bursich Associates Inc. of Pottstown has been awarded the Route 100 and Spring Creek Road design and bridge building projects in Lower Macungie Township.

The projects estimated value is \$1.8 million.

The projects are for the replacement of the superstructure on two single-span bridges. Each structure spans approximately 80 feet. Both bridges are between Macungie and Trexlertown. The Route 100 bridge is over the Little Lehigh Creek and the Spring Creek Road bridge is over Spring Creek. Both bridges were constructed in the late 1950s and have reached the life-span for which they were

designed.

There will only be minor road work associated with the bridge construction. The Spring Creek Road bridge will be built using a detour. The Route 100 bridge will be built maintaining northbound traffic on the bridge with half-width construction and a southbound detour.
